This month has been a busy one, with the start of our vintage teas and multiple other events; including a visit from Bollin Primary School in which we hosted a talk and art-based activity for all pupils involved. Our art filled month continues with the Summer Art exhibition by Altrincham Grammar School for Girls which I will be visiting next week to see the creative talent of last years Trafford School Open students. We are also launching our Schools Trading Cards programme next month so stay tuned for more details.
